Band meal planning, didn't happen during band camp, will get with Mr. Pfanstiel to see what we need to gather for lunches and such for the students. Subway was mentioned, fruit has been donated in the past by band parents. Bags for the students were provided by parents.

Feed the bands fundraiser, started last year, HOH. Pfanstiel will send invites to certain schools who use NW to practice. , boosters will grill hamburgers, cookies, chips, water. \$ 5.25 per meal, we made 3.00 profit from each meal purchased. 2 bands partook in the meals and boosters made 280.00 off fundraiser.

Hospitality-

Bulletin boards for band and vocal are done; pictures will be put up as needed. Tessa and Penny put up the band boards.

Yard signs, all new band, and vocal members will get a yard sign for their yard.

Pfanstiel will get names and how many signs are needed for Band.

Penny has purchased 16 new for 14KG and for 1 new stage manager.

Reimbursement given to June, decorating hallways, for Band and Show Choir, students have eaten the cost to do previously, however the boosters will have a supply tote for band and choir so the students can decorate without having out of pocket costs.
