Saturday, March 7 at 9:00 the indoor stand will be cleaned out and everything moved to the outside stand.

Publicity & Hospitality: Jennifer Evans wasn't able to attend, but two different bulletin boards are going to be done for the musical.

Val made a motion and Stef Balcom seconded it to purchase 30 easels. These will be ordered by the business office with help from Ashley. They will be labeled and stored in the storeroom.
