President's Report-

Concession Report-

Corey thanked everyone for their help in working the stand last year. Looking forward to getting back to a normal concession stand year. Only one stand will be needed for sports.

John Kropatsch will be responsible for filling the propane tanks for the grills. SaDonna and Dave Manfull have agreed to be Grill Master's for home football games again. Coke will be a new vendor for the district. Our representative will be looking at schools similar to our district and start with products they use. He will work on keeping track of what we need each week and get it delivered. If there are any Coke products requested, we will look at possibly adding them. New signage will be added to concession stands. Equipment will be placed August 18th.

Outdoor stand was not cleaned and the grill was used without permission and not cleaned. Rolling cooler was left outdoors.

Floors need to be cleaned. Val Pfenning was checking on getting a cleaner to use on the floor. Some equipment is being loaned out over the summer for use. Discussion was had about why it is being loaned out and no payment for wear and tear on our equipment.

Val Pfenning made a motion to not loan out Music Booster equipment. Jennifer Fischer seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous and passed.

Looking for people who will help with concessions and ordering a picking up food product as needed. John Kropatch, Kate Ames, Terri Saathoff, and Jennifer Fischer have volunteered to help with this.

Chad Fischer motioned that half of the students yearly hours (5 hrs) must be worked by the student to qualify for Music Booster scholarships. Jason Heck approved the motion and Jennifer Fischer seconded. Vote was unanimous and the motion passed. This change will start this year.

Casey Heck proposed a motion that students who work 10 hours in the concession stand each season have their name put into a drawing for a chance to earn a \$50 gift card to a business of their choice. Annette Schimmer approved the motion and Val Pfenning seconded. Motion passed.
